Thanks for the opportunity to comment on your new caravans.

The Free Spirit models are impressive and innovative caravans that take into consideration factors not necessarily addressed by other 'van manufacturers.

I am particularly keen on the alloy chassis, and the fact that your cold-rolling process has eliminated the need for additional structural welding. The chassis is unique in Australia and should prove very successful.

The alloy chassis and frame also leads to a much lighter caravan, which opens up the tow car options for buyers. It towed very well behind the 4-cylinder turbo diesel Triton ute, as it would with other similarly powered vehicles.

The light weight means less power is required in towing, reducing fuel consumption and exhaust pollution, while the internal insulation and solar power options reduce demand on mains power. It could be said that the Free Spirit is a very eco-friendly caravan.

I wish you every success in this venture. You have produced a unique and well designed caravan.
